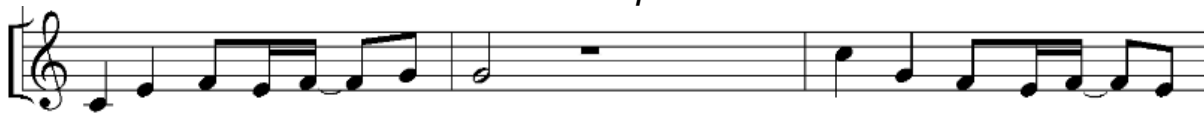

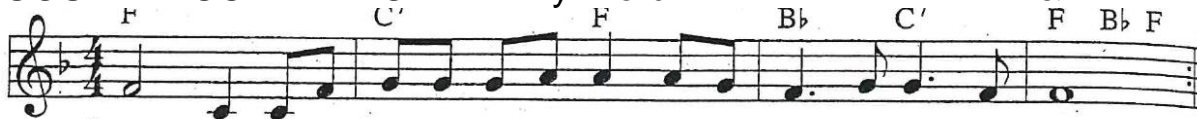

APOSTLES' CREED
