

Day Camp In-Person Initial COVID-19 Policies:

Rainbow Trail would like to move forward with in-person Day Camps in 2021. After consulting with Nurse Carla Herbig, our summer nurse from 2020 who guided a clean and safe summer, we feel the following basic protocols will keep our staff and community safe. This is a living document and will grow and change as

1. Host families must do two weeks of Health/Temperature Checks prior to Day Camp Team Arrival
 - a. If the Congregation cannot provide this- Churches will provide housing at the church.
 - b. If the Congregation cannot provide a safe housing option, we will not send an in-person team.
 - c. RTALC will offer online Day Camp programming at cost for churches unable to meet new expectations, or who are uncomfortable with an in-person Day Camp.
2. Day Camp Participants will be dropped off by the same parent/guardian each day. Before entering, each participant will have their temperature/wellness checked by a staff member or volunteer.
3. RTALC Staff and all Day Camp Campers and Volunteers will be masked at all times indoors and while singing.
4. RTALC Staff and all Day Camp Campers and Volunteers will be masked if within 6 feet of one another outdoors.
5. All sanitization procedures mirrored from Rainbow Trail's onsite entry/exit strategy: sanitize into an activity, sanitize all equipment used, sanitize out of all activities. All volunteers, campers and staff will wash hands before meals.
6. Under the Additional Obligations agreement portion of the Day Camp Contract a line will be added about full accordance with the RTALC COVID-19 Safety procedures (for Board only).
7. RTALC reserves the right to move to 100% online Day Camp if any unforeseen circumstances create an unsafe condition for our staff or community.
